GRADUATE DIVISION COURSES

Graduate courses are numbered from 800 to 999. A senior student pursuing graduate coursework while completing an undergraduate degree is considered an undergraduate student. Seniors at an accredited institution who have obtained in advance the approval of the appropriate campus Dean for Graduate Studies may receive up to 12 hours of credit for graduate courses taken at any campus of the University of Nebraska System in addition to the courses necessary to complete their undergraduate work. Students in an established accelerated master's program at any University of Nebraska campus may begin their graduate enrollment as a junior.

Graduate courses can only be taken to complete the Bachelor's Degree requirements if the student has declared an accelerated graduate program.
